Currently a Chief Scientific Officer in the UK Ministry of Defence acting as Senior Advisor to the Proliferation and Arms Control Secretariat and the Non-proliferation Department of the Foreign and Commonwealth Office on arms control issues and Iraqi disarmament. Formerly Senior Advisor to UNSCOM on biological weapons (1995 to 1999) and a participant in 37 inspections in Iraq from 1991 to 1998 and all technical meetings in Baghdad, New York and Vienna.

Educated at Leeds, Birmingham and Oxford. Undertook a Medical Research Council post doctoral fellowship at the University of Warwick before working for the Natural Environment Research Council Institute of Virology, Oxford, from 1973 to 1984. Subsequently a Senior Principal Scientific Officer and Head of Microbiology at the Chemical Defence Establishment at Porton Down (1984 to 1992). Later Deputy Chief Scientific Officer and Senior Adviser on Biological Defence (1992 to 1996). Now a Dstl Senior Fellow, appointed Dstl level 9, on secondment to Ministry of Defence from 1996.
