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The only other point that we have elicited from Dr Kelly is that he believes there is a 30% chance that Iraq had specific CW production capability in the six months before the war and that it was more likely that there was a small BW production programme. This is not dissimilar to the views ascribed by Gilligan to his source in his evidence to the Foreign Affairs Committee (see answer to Q511). It is worth pointing out that Kelly distinguishes between production and possession where he believes that it is nearer 100% likely that there was some existing CW in Iraq's possession.
