Exec Summ. Para 1:
No mention of use of BW agents, this is described later in the text at page 12, Para 10.
(Aflatoxin)

Executive Summary, Para 3 - 1st Bullet:
The judgement "has continued to produce chemical and biological agents," is too strong with respect to CW. "has probably" would be as far as I would go. And "continued to produce BW agents". This is quite strong considering what the int actually says. [Iraq has a

Executive Summary, Para 3 - 2nd Bullet:
The judgement "has military plans for the use of chemical and biological weapons, some of which could be ready within 45 minutes of an order to use them". Is also rather strong since it is based on a single source. "Could say intelligence suggests..."

Executive Summary, Para 3 - Bullet 4 and 5:
Switch the order.

Executive Summary, Para 3 - 5th Bullet:
Delete "programmes".

Executive Summary, Para 3 - 11th Bullet:
Insert wording "engine test stand for DEVELOPMENT OF missiles..."
