### **Clive Steps Entrance**

**Clive Steps staircase** to first floor, then right into corridor towards **India Office Council Chamber**

Entry to/ exit from Council Chamber via tall carved doors (short talks given in Chamber from 11.00-15.30 hrs: programme overleaf)

Pass **Muses Stair**, along corridor into **Locarno Conference Room** (exhibition stands: full list of all participants overleaf)

Then **Locarno Dining Room** (exhibition stands) through to

Down **Grand Staircase** to Ground Floor, pass **Memorial plaques** into corridor
